

Despite its small population base, North West Queensland contributes significantly to state and national economic and employment outcomes.



The North West Minerals Province is one of the world's richest mineral producing areas with copper, lead, zinc, gold, silver, phosphate, vanadium and rare earth potential.



The region's products have significant flow on benefits for other regions such as Townsville, Cairns and SEQ through processing, port and employment linkages.



Given the abundance of natural resources across the region, facilitating a stronger and more resilient NWQROC region will enhance state and national growth outcomes.
