



The Gap in Supply and Demand of Council Housing across WQAC



Overview

Western Queensland Alliance of Councils (WQAC) surveyed all 23 member councils across three types of housing:

- Council funded
- State funded
- Residential and/or private dwellings

The results from the survey have been collated to show patterns of housing need across the region.

Limitations

Insights drawn are limited by availability of data. Not all councils have been able to provide figures. Those that have provided figures have relied on a range of source information.

The gap identified is representative of the data sets provided where both a current and a demand estimate was provided. The total gap is not intended to provide an exact figure but instead to provide a picture that is indicative of the WQAC housing market.







Local Government Area Boundaries (2022). Darker LGAs represent a higher estimated need with lighter LGAs representing a lower estimated need.




Estimated council housing gap

Six councils comprise **over 50%** of the region's council housing gap.


Primarily, the gap is required to meet demand for council staff housing.

Councils have identified the gap between current supply and estimated demand for housing in the regions (primarily for staff housing purposes).


Sum of Number of Properties

Surveys estimated the number of lots of land across WQAC that are currently connected to services that could be developed.

Additional available lots

It is estimated that additional lots are available for development, however these are not owned by council (privately and state government owned) and it is unclear whether these are connected to services.

Whilst there is sufficient land to service identified need, available land is often not in the required location.






Residential Housing

Councils have identified the percevied gap between current supply and estimated demand for residential housing in the regions.



Additional residential housing required to meet demand















Where is the combined gap for housing greatest?






NWQROC Housing Gaps

Data Dictionary

Term	Explanation	Source
State Housing	General umbrella term to describe both emergency and social housing properties, typically funded by state departments.	
LGA	Local Government Area. Boundaries as at 2021.	
Council – Current (Supply)	The number of residential properties that council currently owns.	Question 1 & 2
Council – Demand	Sum of the current council housing stock and the gap in council housing stock.	Calculation
Council – Gap	The number of properties council is considering adding to their current stock. This assumes that the number being added will meet the unmet need (the gap).	Question 4
Council Housing Purpose (staff/community)	Council properties that are currently leased to council staff as part of their employment package or rented to community members/organisations.	Question 2
Connected Lots	Council owned lots that are available for residential development and connected to services (electricity, roads, water etc.).	Question 9
Zoned Lots	Lots that are zoned for residential development and not owned by council. These lots may not be connected to services.	Question 11
Residential – Gap	The volume of new residential housing the overall community will need over the following years (up to 10 years).	Question 23
Residential Demand Horizon	The timeframe within which council estimates these additional properties will be required.	Question 23
Emergency Housing – Current	Emergency residential housing currently available.	Question 37
Emergency Housing – Demand	Sum of the current emergency housing stock and the gap in emergency housing stock.	Calculation
Emergency Housing – Gap	Emergency residential housing required to meet demand	Question 37
Emergency Housing Purpose	Emergency residential housing required by population sectors (e.g., disability, sleeping rough)	Question 37
Social Housing – Current	Estimate of existing dwellings that the State has for social housing purposes	Question 39
Social Housing – Demand	Estimate of social/affordable housing dwellings that are required, for all purposes.	Question 38
Social Housing - Gap	The difference between social housing demand and current. Where the current supply outstripped demand, the gap was set to 0.	Calculation



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
